The Frisco Marching Band


- Participation required by FISD as part of high school band curriculum
- Includes all brass, woodwind, percussion, and color guard students




- Course credits for P.E. and Fine Arts electives awarded for participation in Marching Band!
- Marching season includes summer camp, participation in band classes, and extracurricular events
- All marching skills are introduced slowly and carefully, 'from the ground up'

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Frisco Marching Band-Rehearsal Schedule



- New Member Marching Camp- Middle/Late April
- Music Camp- End of May
- Summer Band Camp- Starts last week in July, continues through start of school



- ❖ Monday, 5:00 7:30 pm
- ❖ Tuesday, 5:00 7:00 pm Woodwinds, Brass, and Color Guard
- ❖ Wednesday, 6:30 8:00 am Percussion
- Thursday and Friday, 6:30 8:00 am (Color Guard Thursday afternoons instead of morning)
- Occasional special rehearsals due to altered school weeks, special events, etc



Frisco Marching Band-2024 Pre-season Training Events



I. New Member Marching Camp: Tuesday - Thursday, April 16-18, 5:00 - 7:30 pm

- Indoor camp in the gym; a great opportunity to meet student leaders and start bonding as a section, and learn basic marching concepts
- 5:00 pm Check-in and instrument/ name tag distribution in FHS Band Hall; activities from 5:15 7:30 pm
- Students should dress comfortably! Loose athletic clothing and athletic shoes
- Next Future Member Parent Meeting on Thursday, April 18th, 7:00 8:00 pm in FHS Auditorium

II. Music Camp (All Members): Tuesday-Wednesday, May 21-22

- Focus on music indoors; introducing fall music, including the 2024 marching production music!
- Schedule: 9:00 am 12:00 pm, 1:00 4:00 pm both days. Also 6:00 8:00 pm on Wednesday. Students provide own transportation to lunch and dinner, OR ride with section-mates with parent permission
- ❖ Family preview performance of 2023 production- Wednesday, May 22nd, 7:30 8:00 pm in FHS Gymnasium

III. Summer Marching Band Camp (All Members): Begins Monday, July 22nd

- Required for all members of Frisco Marching Band
- We begin putting together our marching production- first football game occurs within a few short weeks!
- Typical schedule includes:
 - > 8:00 11:00 am weekdays, marching outdoors
 - > 12:30 4:30 pm weekdays, music indoors
 - Occasional evening events
 - Special Saturday events, including band registration and social events, possibly some rehearsal
- Occasional additions or deletions from weekday schedule- detailed schedule will be released in June. You may visit www.friscohsband.org to view this past year's archived schedule for reference (password= "raccband")

Frisco Band Student Leadership Team

- Student leaders chosen this spring from upperclassmen
- Undergo multiple hours of leadership training
- Will be tasked with assisting their band peers with music and marching during marching season, as well as helping with equipment, uniforms, and sheet music- they are here to help make your student's experience a great one!

- 1) Drum Majors
- 2) Section Leaders
- 3) Squad Leaders
- 4) Administrative Leaders (Music Team, Uniform Team, Equipment Team, Spirit Team)



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Marching Band Performances

- **❖** Varsity Football Games- 10 games in regular season (11 weeks with bye-week)
 - Required for all band and Color Guard members
 - Mostly on Fridays, some on Thursday evenings
 - Play stands tunes in the bleachers during the game
 - ❖ March on as a band and play for Stars Dance Team during halftime
 - Perform our marching production during halftime
 - Home venues include The Star, Toyota Stadium, Kuykendall Stadium



❖ Marching Show Contests- 4-5 Saturdays in Late September/ October

- Local DFW venues
- Perform our marching production for audience and judges
- Evaluated on musical and visual techniques
- Ranked against other schools in our classification (school size)

Play-A-Thon

- Our student fundraiser for the year
- Saturday in early or mid-September
- ❖ Band performs at local venues and neighborhoods, collects donations
- Donations also collected prior to the event
- ❖ Exact dates for games, contests, and all other performances will be released with the band calendar in June/ Early July

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Marching Band Quick Facts



- ❖ We take extra care to keep students hydrated! Students are required to bring filled water jugs to all outdoor rehearsals- water breaks are given AT LEAST every 15 minutes in warm weather, even more often in summer camp
- ❖ Rehearsal hours are governed by the University Interscholastic League (UIL). The band rehearses about the same amount time as any sport or other organization on campus!

Marching Band Quick Facts

- ❖ Although the schedule during this time of year is our most time-intensive, our students year after year will tell you "It's all worth it" once they feel the thrill of performing for the crowd, and get to spend time with some of their best friends. They also learn valuable timemanagement skills and gain experience working as team.
- Many students will end up counting marching season as their favorite part of the year!





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Concert Band Season



- ***** Encompasses the rest of the year after marching season
- ❖ Schedule will feel similar to the Middle School Band
 - Sectionals once a week outside of school
 - Concerts in December, February, April, and May
- Includes All-Region Band Auditions in the Fall, Solo and Ensemble Event in February

The Frisco Concert Bands

- **❖** 3 Concert Ensemble Classes:
 - Symphonic Band- 1st Period, Mr. Simon and Mr. Courtney
 - ❖ Wind Ensemble- 2nd Period, Mr. Courtney
 - ❖ Wind Symphony- 3rd Period, Mr. Simon



❖ Percussionists are in 1st period percussion-only classes during Fall semester. In the Spring semester they join their concert ensembles on 'A' days.

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The Frisco Concert Bands

- Spring auditions for concert ensembles are submitted via recording in May- more information about logistics to come
 - Major Scales, Chromatic Scale
 - Pre-determined audition etude, will be distributed in early April
- **Freshmen band placements, Spring 2023 auditions:**
 - ❖ Wind Symphony- 3 Freshman
 - **Wind Ensemble- 11 Freshmen**
 - Symphonic Band- 15 Freshmen
- Students have the opportunity to re-audition for band placements in November on the All-Region Band audition music



The Frisco Jazz Band



- Directed by Mr. Courtney
- * Auditions held towards end of marching season in early November
- Rehearsals begin after marching season, typically Tuesday and Thursday mornings
- **❖** Jazz experience is *not* required
- Concerts in December and throughout the Spring

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The Frisco Color Guard

- Directed by Mr. Leikness
- Part of the Frisco Band Organization- performs with the Marching Band in the Fall, then as an indoor 'Winter Guard' in the winter and spring
 - Can be a great option for double reed students during marching season!
- Made up mostly of non-band students; band members are encouraged to invite their friends or siblings to be part of the group!
- Dance experience is not required- much like marching band, skills are taught 'from the beginning'
- ❖ New Member Clinics held April 16th 18th, 2024





The Frisco Percussion Studio

- Directed by Mr. Dillard and Mr. Grimsley
- Students perform and compete as a Drumline in the Fall
- Prepare a percussion ensemble concert throughout the spring, performance in April
- Includes all percussion students
 - Can be another opportunity for double reed students in the Fall marching season

Band Spring Trip

- Taken late Spring
- Optional; most students do attend!
- Parents may attend as chaperones



- Usually in-state, 3 days/2 nights. Every 4 years we head out of state for a longer trip... Class of 2028 will take their out-of-state trip their Junior year!!
- ❖ Payments are spread out over several months. A portion of student and booster fundraising does go towards lowering the cost of the trip for all!





(We strongly encourage double-blocking Band! Select Both 'Band Master' and 'Instrumental Ensemble')



(ALL current middle school band members are accepted into the Frisco Band, regardless of skill level!)

- 3) Students' specific Band ensemble class periods will be assigned and communicated to counselors following auditions
 - 4) Show up ready to have fun and make great friends!



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Scheduling Band...

- Students should 'double-block' band (schedule on 'A day' and 'B day') to benefit the most from more frequent instruction and practice, and make the most progress.
- Special exceptions for students involved in other competitive or performance activities; we work well with all coaches and directors to find a balance.
- Remember that students CAN double block band for 4 years, and STILL have plenty of room to explore other electives!

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
