

Frisco Marching Band-Rehearsal Schedule

- Pre-season training in Spring and Summer:
 - New Member Marching Camp- April 16, 17, 18
 - Music Camp (ALL MEMBERS)- May 21, 22
 - Summer Band Camp- Begins July 22, 2024



- Rehearsal schedule during football season- Start of school through End of October/Early November
 - * Mondays, 5:00 7:30 pm
 - * Tuesdays, 5:00 7:00 pm- Woodwinds, Brass, Color Guard
 - Wednesdays, 5:00- 6:30 pm- Percussion Only
 - Thursdays and Fridays, 6:30 8:00 am (Color Guard- Thursdays will be 5:00 6:30 pm)
 - ✤ Occasional special rehearsals due to altered school weeks, special events, etc

Frisco Marching Band-2024 Pre-season Training Events



I. New Member Marching Camp: Tuesday - Thursday, April 16-18, 5:00 – 7:30 pm

- Indoor camp in the gym; a great opportunity to meet student leaders and start bonding as a section, and learn basic marching concepts
- 5:00 pm Check-in and instrument/ name tag distribution in FHS Band Hall; activities from 5:15 7:30 pm
- Students should dress comfortably! Loose athletic clothing and athletic shoes
- Next Future Member Parent Meeting on Thursday, April 18th, 7:00 8:00 pm in FHS Auditorium

II. Music Camp (All Members): Tuesday-Wednesday, May 21-22

- Focus on music indoors; introducing fall music, including the 2024 marching production music!
- Schedule: 9:00 am 12:00 pm, 1:00 4:00 pm both days. Also 6:00 8:00 pm on Wednesday. Students provide own transportation to lunch and dinner, OR ride with section-mates with parent permission
- Family preview performance of 2024 production- Wednesday, May 22nd, 7:30 8:00 pm in FHS Gymnasium

III. Summer Marching Band Camp (All Members): Begins Monday, July 22nd

- ✤ Required for all members of Frisco Marching Band
- We begin putting together our marching production- first football game occurs within a few short weeks!
- ✤ Typical schedule includes:
 - > 8:00 11:00 am weekdays, marching outdoors
 - > 12:30 4:30 pm weekdays, music indoors
 - Occasional evening events
 - > Special Saturday events, including band registration and social events, possibly some rehearsal
- Occasional additions or deletions from weekday schedule- detailed schedule will be released in June. You may visit <u>www.friscohsband.org</u> to view this past year's archived schedule for reference (password= "raccband")

Marching Band Performances Varsity Football Games- 10 games in regular season (11 weeks with bye-week)

- Required for all band and Color Guard members
 - Mostly on Fridays, some on Thursday evenings
- Play stands tunes in the bleachers during the game
- * March on as a band and play for Stars Dance Team during halftime
- Perform our marching production during halftime
- Home venues include The Star, Toyota Stadium, Kuykendall Stadium

✤ Marching Show Contests- 4-5 Saturdays in Late September/ October

- ✤ Local DFW venues
- Perform our marching production for audience and judges
- Evaluated on musical and visual techniques
- Ranked against other schools in our classification (school size)

Marching Band Quick Facts

- We take extra care to keep students hydrated! Students are required to bring filled water jugs to all outdoor rehearsals- water breaks are given AT LEAST every 15 minutes in warm weather, even more often in summer camp
- Rehearsal hours are governed by the University Interscholastic League (UIL). The band rehearses about the same amount time as any sport or other organization on campus!







Marching Band Quick Facts

- Although the schedule during this time of year is our most time-intensive, our students year after year will tell you "It's all worth it" once they feel the thrill of performing for the crowd, and get to spend time with some of their best friends. They also learn valuable time-management skills and gain experience working as team.
- * Many students will end up counting marching season as their favorite part of the year!

Frisco Band Auditions



- * Take place via recorded upload, due May 3rd
- * Music, with upload instructions, was given to students early April
- Audition includes major scales- as many as they can perform at a steady tempo- and a chromatic scale
- Audition 'etudes' (short piece). The first four sections of each are required for everyone; the last two sections are optional and should be performed to be considered for Wind Symphony (top band)
- ***** We want everyone to relax and do their best!

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The Frisco Concert Bands

- ***** 3 Concert Ensemble Classes:
 - Symphonic Band- 1st Period, Mr. Simon and Mr. Courtney
 - **Wind Ensemble-** 2nd Period, Mr. Courtney
 - ✤ Wind Symphony- 3rd Period, Mr. Simon



- All 3 Concert Bands perform at concerts, participate in Solo and Ensemble, have the chance to participate in All-Region auditions, and perform quality music
- Percussionists are in 1st period percussion-only classes during Fall semester. In Spring semester they join their concert ensembles on 'A' days.

The Frisco Concert Bands

- ✤ Spring auditions for concert ensembles are submitted via recording in May-more information about logistics to come
 - * Major Scales, Chromatic Scale
 - * Pre-determined audition etude, will be distributed in early April

Freshmen band placements, Spring 2023 auditions:

- Wind Symphony- 3 Freshman
- Wind Ensemble- 11 Freshmen
- Symphonic Band-15 Freshmen



Students have the opportunity to re-audition for band placements in November on the All-Region Band audition music

Private Lessons




- We have an outstanding private teaching staff here at FHS!




- Online signatures and pre-registration fee due by <u>Tuesday, May 21st</u>
- * The first round of form signatures for pre-registration will be collected ONLINE this year
- \$100 pre-registration fee goes towards summer expenses- materials and instruction for May Music Camp, July-August Summer Band Camp
- Online payment through CutTime is preferable; Checks made payable to "Frisco Band Booster Association" can be given to director or turned in to the band hall deposit box
- ✤ Forms include marching band physical examination and medical history forms, FISD offcampus activity release, UIL Rules Acknowledgement, UIL Cardiac Awareness form
- DCI Show- optional but SUPER HIGHLY encouraged!

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Pre-Registration Packet-Physical Exam and Medical History



- Physical exam- requirement for marching band students from the University Interscholastic League (UIL); matches requirement for athletes
 - Parents are encouraged to have the student's primary care physician perform the exam due to the pre-existing medical relationship with the student.
 - Parents are encouraged to keep the *original* medical history and physical examination forms and provide copies to the high school band director.
 - Must be completed by July 21st, ready to be turned in to band directors on first day of summer band camp (July 22nd)
 - ***** Athletics students can get ONE physical, then turn in a copy of form to both organizations
- Medical history form- filled out by the family, turned in <u>with</u> physical examination form (filled out and signed by doctor)
